Annual Report 2013-2014





We are pleased to share with you the 2013 Annual Report to the Community for the United Way of Northern Ozaukee.

Our 2013 fundraising goal was \$275,000. Although some of our workplace campaigns saw growth, overall the United Way campaign fell short of its goal. For the fiscal year 2013-2014 (ending March 31, 2014) our campaign raised over \$250,000. The dollars raised remained flat from last year's campaign. We continue to be thankful for your generosity. Our total represents over 825 donors.

Throughout the year, we have seen and heard countless stories of people who have been helped by a United Way program. For instance, a woman talks about how Family Sharing helped her get through a rough period after she lost her job. Family Sharing helped fill the gap with food and basic necessities until she could find another job. After five months, she expressed her appreciation and said that she no longer needed Family Sharing because she had found a job.

From Balance Inc. we learned about how their Supported Living Program helped an individual with developmental disabilities move into his first apartment at 40 years of age. He is learning how to manage his own money, menu planning and preparation and other daily living activities. Thanks to the support from agencies like Balance, Interfaith Caregivers, Ozaukee Circle of Friends, and Portal, individuals with disabilities are leading more inclusive lives where they succeed and thrive. It is these stories that push us to work hard every day to achieve our goals.


